#### **PSAT Student Results**


Earlier this year, students in grades 9–11 completed the PSAT 8/9 or PSAT/NMSQT assessment. Scores were released to students through CollegeBoard.com earlier this month. Students were also given a paper copy of their results. This diagnostic exam has many benefits in identifying students for college scholarships as well as provide a predictive measurement for the Junior year SAT exam. NPHS staff has set a school goal on improving SAT scores for our Juniors, and we will be actively assisting students in understanding the assessment format, types and rigor of questions, and strategies useful for standardized testing.

### **NPHS Athletics Spotlight**

New Prairie Senior Cross Country runner Logan Thibodeau capped off his impressive career at the IHSAA State Finals on Saturday, Nov. 2nd. Facing a challenging field of the state's top runners, Logan finished with a time of 16:32.96, placing 134th overall. Entering the Fall with a pre-season ranking of 355th in the state, he displayed a relentless work ethic consistently breaking his personal best times throughout the season and earned a trip to Terre Haute. Along the way, Logan also claimed individual 1st place finishes at both the Penn and NP Invitationals becoming the first NP boy runner to win the NP Invite in over 20 years.

The NP Volleyball team hoisted a Sectional Championship Trophy in an exciting 4-set victory (21-25, 25-21, 25-22, 25-19) over Mishawaka Marian. The team advanced to the NorthWood Regional, but fell to the host school 17-25, 32-30, 17-25, 19-25. The Cougars finished their season with a 23-12 overall record and were also the New Prairie Invitational Champions.

Our New Prairie Football team continues their postseason IHSAA tournament with a home Sectional Championship game on Friday, November 8th at 7pm CST. Come and cheer on your NP Cougars on their quest for another Sectional Championship!
