FLEX Day - February 26th

On Wednesday, February 26th, NPUSC has a planned Flex Day. These are professional development days for staff. Students are assigned work to complete on their iPads from home. Students are required to "check-in" for the day through Schoology, and then complete any tasks assigned by their teachers for that day. Staff will be able to respond to questions and emails at various times throughout the day until 3:00pm. As a reminder, students do not report to the schools on Flex Days, and they do not have live instruction via Zoom. This is different than weather cancellation days, in which the synchronous learning plan at the end of this newsletter would be followed.









World Language Department Spotlight

Our NPHS World Language department is dedicated to teaching Spanish and French using Comprehensible Input (CI) and Teaching Proficiency through Reading and Storytelling (TPRS). Growth in the four domains of reading, writing, listening, and speaking are determined by the nationally-recognized ACTFL proficiency standards and the Indiana equivalents. Our year-end tests for Spanish and French II and higher use the Standards-based Measurement of Proficiency (STAMP) test to accurately provide proficiency data for our students. If students earn Intermediate High (end of Spanish V-equivalent, even though we only have through Spanish IV) on all four domains, and they successfully pass the SAT for English, they will earn the Certificate of Multilingual Proficiency (CoMP). Last year, in our charter year of testing, 17 students successfully passed the STAMP at or above the Intermediate High level on all four domains!

Many parents remember conjugating and writing sentences everyday during their high school WL class...and not remembering anything. Those days are over! The use of CI and TPRS has drastically changed how quickly students can grow in their language skills. Plus, we get to practice in fun and different ways, using running dictation, manipulative sorts, movie talks, inner and outer circles for talking, listening to both infamous and current music, and more!

HOMEWORK CLUB

NPHS is offering afterschool help for both math and English/Language Arts. These free tutoring sessions are hosted in the NPHS Library from 2:30–3:00pm. Teachers from our Math and ELA departments will be there to assist students with assignments or reteaching of essential content.

- Math help is available on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- ELA help is available on Mondays and Thursday.


